





For the first time in nearly 25 years, Princess Diana's iconic wedding dress is on display in a new Kensington Palace exhibit, "Royal Style in the Making." "It will be like seeing an old friend after all these years," says Elizabeth Emanuel, who designed the spectacular taffeta and lace gown for Diana's 1981 nuptials to Prince Charles. "I was looking at the images again today,

and I can't believe how many sequins we sewed onto the dress."

The exhibit also features other significant historical pieces, including a rare surviving toile for the 1937 coronation gown of the queen mother, and never-before-seen items from the archives of some of the most celebrated royal couturiers of the 20th century. Says Matthew Storey, exhibition curator at Historic Royal Palaces: "We've got some real surprises up our sleeve for fashion fans!"

The CNN Anchor Opens Up About Her Cancer Diagnosis

CHRISTIANE AMANPOUR shared some surprising news with her viewers when she returned from a monthlong absence on June 14. “The last four weeks have been a bit of a roller-coaster for me, because during that time I’ve been diagnosed with ovarian cancer,” said the veteran newswoman, 63. “I’ve had successful major surgery to remove it, and I’m now undergoing several months of chemotherapy for the very best possible long-term prognosis.

I’m confident.” During her announcement, Christiane, who is based in London, said she feels “fortunate to have health insurance through work and incredible doctors who are treating me.” She also called attention to the fact that ovarian cancer is all too common, affecting “millions of women around the world.” She noted the importance of early detection. “I want to urge women to educate themselves on this disease...and to always listen to your bodies.”

Friendship, Betrayal, Forgiveness

HOW THE HOLLYWOOD ICONS FOUND THEIR WAY BACK TO EACH OTHER AFTER A BROKEN TRUST TORE THEM APART

In 1966, Debbie Reynolds and her second husband were in New York waiting to board the RMS *Queen Elizabeth* to England when she spotted the baggage. “I saw tons of luggage going by me and birdcages and dog cages and nurses, and I realized Elizabeth was on the same ship as me,” she remembered. “I almost changed my mind about going, but my husband said, ‘Don’t be silly.’”

Seven years after Elizabeth Taylor had run off with Debbie’s first husband, singer Eddie Fisher, the two actresses and former friends found themselves trapped together on an ocean liner. “I sent a note to her room, and she sent a note back to mine saying that we should have dinner and get this over with and have a good time,” recalled Debbie, who accepted the invitation. “She’d moved along in her life, and so had I.”

Elizabeth, who began acting at age 9, was already a star when she and a teenage Debbie met at MGM Studios. “We went to school together on the lot,” recalled Debbie. “I was just a beginner, and she and I were not in any manner alike, but we got along very well because I was in awe.”

Debbie, of course, would go on to become a star

too, in classic films like 1952’s *Singin’ in the Rain*. Three years later, she wed teen idol Eddie Fisher, and the couple were hailed as America’s sweethearts. “There’s no doubt my father was the love of her life,” the couple’s son, Todd Fisher, tells *Closer*. “I know how much they loved each other.”

THE ULTIMATE BLINDSIDE

When Elizabeth married her third husband, Michael Todd, in 1957, Debbie and Eddie were their witnesses. The foursome were so tight that Debbie and Eddie named their son Todd after Elizabeth’s husband. So it’s little surprise that Mike’s sudden death in a plane crash a year later left all of them devastated. Debbie generously offered to watch Elizabeth’s three children and sent Eddie over to her house to keep an eye on her. “He went with my blessing,” Debbie wrote in her 2013 memoir, *Unsinkable*. “The four of us were so close, I was sure he could comfort her.”

The affair that began between Elizabeth and Eddie would turn Debbie’s world upside down. “I was the last to find out,” she confessed. “There had been hints in the papers, and I had noticed that when I turned up at functions or parties on

my own, my friends were whispering.... Even so, it was a great shock to find them together. I was shattered.”

The public took Debbie's side of the scandal and branded Elizabeth a home-wrecker. Eddie came off even worse. His self-titled TV series was canceled. He also lost his recording contract. “My father accused [Debbie] of turning the public against him, but it was just his behavior that caused that,” says Todd, a witness to his father's callous actions. “I have a telegram from when I was 2 from ‘Liz and Eddie’ wishing me a happy birthday,” he says. “Why would anybody send a telegram to a 2-year-old? The answer is to [mess] with Debbie! My father was prone to that behavior. Liz didn't even know about it.”

THE POWER OF LOVE

Of course, Elizabeth and Eddie's marriage didn't last — she left him for Richard Burton in 1964. By the time Debbie and Elizabeth met up on the ship, they had both moved on. “My mother was a class act,” says Todd, who released a memoir, *My Girls: A Lifetime With Carrie and Debbie*, in 2018. “She handled it with such grace.”

Elizabeth, meanwhile, sought forgiveness, not just from Debbie but from the children who had been hurt by Debbie and Eddie's divorce. “Many years later, Liz insisted on telling me in great detail the whole story of what she was feeling when she went off with my dad,” says Todd, who explains that Elizabeth called it “a tragic rebound off of the death of the love of her life, Mike Todd.”

Debbie's older child, Carrie Fisher, also accepted Elizabeth's apology. She even helped bring the former friends closer by writing *These Old Broads*, a 2001 TV movie about aging actresses that Debbie and Elizabeth agreed to star in. The movie included a scene where their characters forgive each other for fighting over an ex-lover named “Freddy.” “That was the moment they became close again,” says Todd. “They literally started talking to each other for hours.”

▶ “I was a virgin when I married Eddie,” said Debbie, with Carrie, Eddie and Todd. “I was very religious, so I didn't believe in divorce.”

Todd recalls taking a private plane to an AIDS march in San Francisco with his mother and Elizabeth. “It was fun to see them together again,” he says. “It was magical. The forgiveness that took place between them was important.”

And that bond remained intact for the rest of their lives. “People always assume you're going to carry a grudge, but I don't do that,” said Debbie, who visited her friend often in the last months of her life and was bequeathed a matching sapphire necklace, bracelet and earrings set by Elizabeth following her 2011 death. “We passed through that with time.”



A LONGTIME FRIEND OF THE LEGENDARY CROONER
RECALLS A GENTLE SOUL WHO LOVED HELPING OTHERS




Frank Sinatra was the King of the Rat Pack — a charismatic bad boy, known nearly as much for his swagger as he was for his golden voice. But one of his closest friends, Tony Oppedisano, saw a side of Ol' Blue Eyes that was kinder — and more compelling — than the legend. “Most people would think he would say his greatest accomplishment was one of his huge records like *My Way*,” Tony tells *Closer* in an exclusive interview. “But I think [he’d say] his greatest accomplishment was trying to ... help as many people as he possibly could, whether he knew them or not.”

Tony ought to know. He was in Frank’s inner circle for decades. A former jazz musician, he first met the crooner in 1972 through a mutual friend, nightclub owner Jilly Rizzo. As they grew closer, he went on to become a member of Frank’s management team — as well as one of his most trusted confidants. “He taught me some of the

greatest life lessons,” says Tony, who details his experiences with the Chairman of the Board in the new book *Sinatra and Me: In the Wee Small Hours*. “He was like a second father to me.”

Rest assured, **Tony says, Frank treasured his own children, Nancy, 81, Tina, 72, and Frank Jr., who passed away in 2016 at the age of 72. “He went out of his way to be the best father he could,” Tony recalls.**




Frank and his first wife, Nancy, were married from 1939 to 1951. They had three kids together.

hard to protect them. “It was in his DNA from growing up,” Tony says of Frank’s natural instinct to take care of those who needed it — something that extended beyond family. He’d help out his friends “emotionally and financially,” says Tony, even paying for life-saving surgeries. Frank was also there for his onetime girlfriend Marilyn Monroe (“He felt that she was... almost like a frightened little girl) and his third wife, Mia Farrow, for whom he remained a strong shoulder to cry on long after they split.

REGRETS, HE’S HAD A FEW


The most surprising thing about Frank? He couldn’t stand conflict. “As tough a guy as he was — and God bless him, he grew up in a tough neighborhood — when he got into any kind of conflict with someone he cared deeply about,

like his kids or [his fourth wife] Barbara, he would almost become a little kid and try to make the world go away,” Tony relates. “He didn’t like to argue with people he loved.”

Decades after leaving his first wife, Nancy, for Ava Gardner, Frank still felt bad about the hurt he caused her. “We were on a flight overseas once, and everyone on the plane was asleep,” Tony recalls. “He was talking about the night he won the Academy Award for *From Here to Eternity* and how, when he went back to the house, Mrs. Nancy had organized a gathering for him. He... felt overwhelmed, and he rushed out. He regretted that.”

Indeed, Frank was a surprisingly sensitive soul, right up to the very end. Says Tony: “I miss him as much as my own father.”

Makes 16

- 1 box frozen puff pastry sheets, thawed**
- 7 oz. guava or quince paste, cut into 16 squares, 1/8 x 1" thick, or 1 cup marmalade of your choice**
- 4 oz. feta cheese, patted dry and cut into 16 squares, 1/8 x 1" thick**
- 1 egg, whisked**
- 2 tbsp. Demerara sugar**

1. Heat oven to 375°F. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper. Unfold 1 of the puff pastry sheets, keeping the second in the refrigerator. Dust the

countertop with flour and roll out pastry to a 12 x 12" square. Cut out 16 disks using a 3" round cutter or a glass. Transfer disks to a baking sheet.

2. Place 1 piece of guava paste and one piece of cheese on half the disks. Brush outer rim with egg and top with an empty disk. Press edges, brush with egg and sprinkle with sugar.

3. Transfer to the preheated oven and bake until puffed up and golden brown, 18 to 20 min. Repeat with remaining ingredients. Serve warm.

BRAISED PORK LOIN WITH MINT

Serves 6

- 1 (2½ lb.) center-cut pork loin
- 2 tsp. kosher salt
- 2 tbsp. canola oil
- ¼ cup dark rum
- ⅓ cup tamarind paste, seeds removed
- 2 small red onions, quartered through root end
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 3 tbsp. brown sugar
- 1 tbsp. grated fresh or prepared horseradish
- ½ cup mint leaves, chopped

1. Heat oven to 325°F. Season pork with salt and pepper to taste. Let stand at room

temp. 15 to 30 min.
 2. Heat oil in a 10" cast-iron skillet. Sear the roast on all sides, about 15 to 20 min.
 3. Transfer roast to a rimmed platter. Turn heat to medium, add rum to pan and bring to a simmer. Cook 45 sec. Add next 4 ingredients and pork; transfer to oven and roast 40 to 50 min. until the meat reaches 145°F.
 4. Transfer pork to a serving platter. Tent with foil and let rest 10 to 15 min. Stir horseradish and mint into sauce. Cut pork into medallions and serve with sauce and onions.

CHOCOLATE, TAMARIND & CASHEW TART

Serves 10

- ¾ cup raw plus ¼ cup toasted cashews
- ¾ cup buckwheat flour
- ⅓ cup coconut oil
- ¼ cup plus ⅓ cup brown sugar
- 8 oz. 70% dark chocolate, chopped
- 1 cup whole milk Greek yogurt
- ½ cup tamarind paste, seeds removed
- 1½ cups heavy cream

1. Heat oven to 375°F. In a food processor, pulse raw cashews and flour. Add oil, ¼ cup brown sugar and a pinch of salt; pulse until dough comes

together. Press into a 10" fluted tart pan. Freeze 20 min.
 2. Place crust on a sheet pan; bake 8 to 10 min. Cool on a rack.
 3. In a bowl over boiling water, melt chocolate and remaining brown sugar. Cool.
 4. In a bowl, whisk yogurt and tamarind; fold in chocolate. Pour into crust; chill 1 hr.
 5. Place a stand mixer bowl and whisk in the freezer for 10 min. In bowl, whisk cream to form soft peaks.
 6. Sprinkle tart with toasted cashews and sea salt and serve with whipped cream.

HOW TO REDUCE LOWER BACK PAIN

FROM STANDING TALL TO MOVING MORE, THESE SIMPLE TIPS CAN HELP YOUR BACK FEEL BETTER

MOVE: Sitting too much can wreak havoc on your lower back, as it puts pressure on the cushioned discs between the bones in your spine. “Every 30 minutes, get up and walk around,” says Dr. Joel Press, Physiatrist-in-Chief at Hospital for Special Surgery in New York City. Look for a fitness tracker that sends alerts when it’s time to get moving, or try a sit-stand desk. Studies show that chronic lower back pain dropped by up to 50 percent in people who combined a sit-stand desk with walking breaks.

STAND TALL: Poor posture puts strain on the back muscles and ligaments. Make sure your shoulders are back, your stomach is pulled in, and your feet are about shoulder-width apart when you’re standing. When sitting, keep both feet flat on the floor — don’t cross your legs!

STRETCH OUT: Tight hamstrings (the three posterior thigh muscles in between the hip and the knee) can cause lower back pain. Simple hamstring stretches can ease the pressure on your pelvis and provide relief.

TAKE A BREAK: If you’ve been bending for a prolonged period of time, such as while gardening, it’s important to stand up and give your back a rest before attempting any strenuous activity, like lifting a bag of soil. Doing so will allow the spinal tissues to recover and prevent injury.

LOSE IT: It’s time to shed that extra weight! “Even losing just five pounds can take a load off your spine,” Dr. Press explains.

The Fitbit Inspire 2 reminds you to take 250 steps every hour (\$99.95; fitbit.com). Working at a sit-stand desk takes pressure off the spine.



MICKY DOLENZ

I'm Still a
BELIEVER

The performer reflects on fame, his career path and his final tour as the Monkees



The Monkees aired from 1966 to 1968. "It was like being in the eye of a hurricane," Micky says.



Micky married Donna Quinter in 2002. He is the father of four daughters.

The Monkees was not the only television pilot about a musical group that Micky Dolenz auditioned for in 1965. "I was up for three others besides *The Monkees* that season," Micky confides to *Closer*. "There was one like a Beach Boys surfer band, one about a big family kind of a folk group, and another one like Peter, Paul and Mary. It was in the air." Of course, *The Monkees*, which cast Micky as the curly haired drummer of a fledgling rock act, was the only one that got on the air. It became a hit both as a television series and on radio, where songs like "Last Train to Clarksville," "Steppin' Stone" and "I'm a Believer" put the Monkees at the top of the *Billboard* charts.

This September, Micky will reunite with Mike Nesmith, the other surviving member of the group, for the 2021 "Monkees Farewell Tour." Micky, 76, also recently released his first solo album in nine years, *Dolenz Sings Nesmith*, composed of songs Mike wrote throughout his career, including some Monkees' deep cuts.

Is this really the final Monkees tour?

The short answer is yes. I think this is the last time Mike and I will get together as the Monkees. We questioned whether we should have even called it the Monkees. It's a different show because the other two main guys, David [Jones] and Peter [Tork]

aren't with us anymore. So, yes, I think this is probably the last hurrah.

You still must get recognized a lot. How do you deal with the attention?

Well, the last year has been a blessing because I'm wearing a mask all the time! [Laughs] I don't want to say I've enjoyed it, because so many people suffered so terribly, but the anonymity and not living out of a suitcase have been nice.

Why do you think the Monkees continue to resonate with new generations?

The Monkees, as a group, never made it on the TV show. It was always about their struggle for success. Those struggles are the stories that tend to resonate with generations, regardless of the style, the music and the costumes of the time. It resonates and always will.

Did you grow up wanting to be an actor?

No, never. Not to this day! My parents were both in the business, so I was around it from childhood. I was studying to be an architect when I got *The Monkees* audition. If I couldn't be an architect, I was going to fall back on show business.

Can you share one fond memory of filming the show?

No, to be honest, not one; the whole thing is one big, long memory. It was only a few years, but between filming the television

show 10 to 12 hours a day, then recording at night and rehearsing on weekends, it was very intense. I remember people along the way much more than I remember moments. Co-stars like Rose Marie, who I got along with famously.

How did you become the primary singer with the Monkees?

We were all cast into this television show, not just as actors, but as singers, musicians and entertainers. I remember clearly going into the studio and singing lead vocals on some of the songs that Davy ended up singing. I also remember Davy doing lead vocals on some of the same songs I ended up singing. As it turned out, I ended up doing the majority of the lead vocals, including the theme song. But it was all out of our hands.

Your voice does have a distinctive sound.

Well, Mike had, and still does have, quite a country feel — and that was not as mainstream as it is today. Peter had a very folksy, Greenwich Village sensibility, and Davy was, of course, just off Broadway. I was the rock 'n' roller. I think I ended up doing more of the vocals by default.

Was it ever a burden to be known as Micky from *The Monkees*?

Not for me ever, although I can't speak for anyone else. After *The Monkees*, I went to England and produced and directed

TV shows and commercials for 15 years. I've always looked at *The Monkees* as a blessing because it opened up so many doors for me. But you do get typecast. I'll be honest, it was a bit frustrating when I'd hear that I was up for something as an actor or director and they'd say, "We really don't need a drummer."

But the whole experience was more positive than negative?

Oh, I'm very grateful. I've been blessed my whole life. I'm blessed with my children. I'm blessed with my marriages — I'm on my third marriage — but I've been blessed with the women that have been in my life, the mothers of my children. And, of course, with getting cast on *The Monkees*.

What makes you proud professionally?

The music, the performances, the audiences. I have to say thanks to them for being around so long.

How did your new album *Dolenz Sings Nesmith* come about?

It goes way back. My best friend was singer-songwriter Harry Nilsson, who recorded *Nilsson Sings Newman*, [an album] of the songs of Randy Newman. I thought it was a great idea. So I've had this



Why do you think fans will like it?


I suppose my fans will like it because I’m doing it. And Nesmith fans are going to like it for his songs. And Monkees fans will like it for the obvious Monkee-related reasons, but in my opinion, the material and the end product are just really, really good.

How do you like being a grandfather?

My children were very concerned about me [during COVID-19]. I’m 76 years old with high blood pressure. They didn’t want me traveling or going anywhere until it felt relatively safe. So this is it. I’m seeing my grandkids for the first time in a long time. And I’m loving it!

Do you think you will ever retire?

I tried it once, and I got bored, so it’s not in my plans right now. —Louise A. Barile, reporting by Katie Bruno




AN UNEXPECTED GIFT





In Bedford Village, N.Y., Tallulah Bankhead owned a Tudor-inspired home she christened Windows. (It had 75!) She threw frequent parties and, if the mood struck her, she'd perform for her guests standing on top of her grand piano wearing only pearls. "Live in the moment," she said.

Born into an old Southern family, Tallulah grew up overshadowed by her prettier older sister. She compensated by being outspoken and outrageous, a habit which would make her a star of the London stage and a subject of gossip columns. "My father warned me about men and booze," the husky-voiced diva once purred, "but he never said anything about women and cocaine." In fact, she carried on affairs with both sexes, smoked, drank and drugged to excess, and claimed to have only come to Hollywood to sleep with Gary Cooper.

Tallulah's politician father, who became Speaker of the House, didn't know what to make of her. "Her mother and father had been frustrated actors, so her family was proud but also horrified," Joel Lobenthal, author of *Tallulah! The Life and Times of a Leading Lady*, tells *Closer*.

LARGER THAN LIFE

Even fans who have never seen Tallulah's films know the persona she created: The chain-smoking, fur-wearing actress is said to have inspired *101 Dalmatian's* Cruella de Vil. Throughout her life, she never tired of her notoriety. Shortly before her death in 1968 from emphysema, Tallulah played Black Widow, a bank robber who called *Batman's* Adam West "Bat Doll." When directed to be arch in the role, Tallulah bristled. "Don't talk to me about camp, dahling," she said. "I invented it!"—Reporting by Lexi Ciccone





5 **2000 PLAYING POLITICS**


