Little House *on the* Prairie

We Were a Real Family

THE CAST REMEMBER THE JOYS, LAUGHTER AND HEARTACHE OF CREATING THE BELOVED SHOW

In the TV movie that ended the story of *Little House on the Prairie*, the citizens of Walnut Creek blow up their town so that the land's new owners wouldn't get the benefit of their years of hard work. The spectacle was series star and producer Michael Landon's idea. "He literally strapped dynamite on all those buildings and blew them to smithereens in one take," recalls Melissa Francis, who played Cassandra Cooper Ingalls. "He wanted to go out with a bang."

For the former child actors who grew up on the set of the beloved historical drama, which originally aired from 1974 to 1983, it was primarily a time filled with love, laughter and the start of many relationships that would last a lifetime. "We were very lucky," Melissa Gilbert, who played Laura "Half-pint" Ingalls, tells *Closer*. "We were like a second family."

Little House's younger cast members share almost uniform-

ly happy tales of time at Big Sky Ranch, where the series' exterior scenes were filmed. "It was the best game of dress-up anybody played ever in the history of the world," gushes Melissa, 57. "I wore actual high-button shoes. We had wagons to ride, horses, cattle, chickens, and other kids to play with."

On the show, snobby Nellie Oleson was Laura's sworn enemy, but Melissa and Alison Arnglim, 59, who played Nellie, became best friends. "I used to say they tried to take our childhoods, but Melissa and I kept stealing them back," Alison quips to *Closer*. "We were always doing crazy things, pranking people and carrying on. We liked to go out in public, get recognized and freak people out."

On set, Michael would often join in the pranks. "We used to catch frogs in the creek," recalls Rachel Greenbush, 51, who split the role of young Carrie Ingalls with her twin sister, Sidney. "We would bring them back to Michael. He would put them in his mouth, walk up to

people, open his mouth and the frog would jump out! People would freak out!"

But the majority of the time, Michael ran "a very tight ship," and when action was called, playtime was over. "He knew exactly what he wanted with every shot and every scene," says Alison, who adds that on set "there was no real drama because Michael wouldn't allow it."

FAMILY FEUDS

Still, not everyone got along 100 percent of the time. Like a real family, there were hurt feelings and misunderstandings. Melissa Sue Anderson, 58, who played eldest daughter Mary Ingalls, didn't mix with the other kids. "She was quiet and kept to herself a lot," Alison says.

Melissa Gilbert admits she also never got close to her, even though they played sisters. "There was a distance to her, a coldness, though sometimes I wonder if it was just that I never knew how to get her to let me in," Melissa wrote in



her 2009 book *Prairie Tales: A Memoir*. “She wasn’t easy to get along with.”

More serious tension developed between Michael and Karen Grassle, 79, who played his wife, Caroline “Ma” Ingalls. “When we were in the top 10, I said, ‘Gee, it is time to renegotiate my contract,’ [but] Michael did not want to pay me,” says Karen. “It was very difficult.” So much so, that Karen left *Little House* in 1982.

It couldn’t have always been easy for Michael, the show’s producer, star and sometimes director. Karen describes him as “moody” and notes that he was under a lot of pressure. When *Little House*’s ratings started to dip in the 1980s, he attempted to save the show by centering plots on the younger cast members.

Around the same time, Michael divorced Lynn, his wife of 19 years, and a year later married Cindy Clerico, who worked on the *Little House* set in the makeup department. “My family’s allegiance was with Lynn, so my relationship with Mike began to dissolve,” wrote Melissa. “I wasn’t supposed to feel anything because he wasn’t my real father... I was put in a horribly uncomfortable position.”

SWEET REUNIONS

Before Michael, a lifelong smoker, passed away in 1991 at the age of 54, he reconciled with both Karen and Melissa. “We had a friendly phone call about the good old days,” recalls Karen. “I was glad we had that healing.”

Melissa also came to understand that the man she once looked up to as a hero was also an ordinary, flawed person. After several years of not speaking, she saw Michael at the wedding of his daughter Leslie. “We bridged that gap instantly with hugs and kisses. It felt so good to have his strong arms

wrapped around me again and to breathe in that familiar Mike smell,” wrote Melissa, who paid the ultimate tribute to her television dad in 1995 when she named her youngest son, Michael Boxleitner, after him.

Viewers who tuned in each week to watch the continuing story of the Ingallses and their neighbors in Walnut Creek often came away uplifted by the show’s ability to reflect real life despite its historical setting. “It was a bright spot in

people’s childhoods,” says Karen, explaining that the show satisfied “a longing for community, family, loyalty and safety. It was a wonderful place to be.”

And for the actors who brought it to life, their days on *Little House* still hold a cherished place in their memories. “There is a whole group of people that I worked with those many years ago, who will not call me anything but Half-pint,” says Melissa. “And that’s perfectly fine with me.”

THE COUNTRY SINGER'S DAUGHTERS AND BEST FRIEND RECALL HER GENEROSITY, HUMOR AND BEST ADVICE

Her life could be the lyrics of a country song. After living in poverty and marrying for the first time at 17, country singer Tammy Wynette achieved astronomical success. However, stardom didn't equal happiness. She suffered the heartbreak of five failed marriages, abuse at the hands of her last husband George Richey, 26 hospitalizations due to serious health problems — and a prescription pill addiction that ultimately took her life in 1998 at the age of 55.

Yet beyond the drama, the “Stand by Your Man” singer was the devoted mother of four daughters — three by her first husband, Euple Byrd, and one by her third husband George Jones — and she showed them a side of herself that no one else knew. Levelheaded, fun-loving and generous to a fault, Tammy gave the girls her full attention, cooking for them, offering sage advice and even taking them on tour. “She was just wonderful. She was the best,” Tammy’s second eldest daughter, Jackie Daly, tells *Closer*. “She was most happy with family.”

Indeed, Tammy’s children remained her first priority, no matter how busy her career made her. “There were times when she’d just come off the road and she was exhausted. But she’d say, ‘Girls, pack up, we’re driving to Florida,’” Jackie recalls. “We’d load up and she’d drive through the

night.” The singer’s best friend, Linda Cayson, recalls how Tammy worried over her girls when she couldn’t be with them. “After she became a star, she was on the road a lot,” she tells *Closer*. “It bothered her because she wanted to be a good mom.”

Putting her children first was something that continued into her daughters’ adulthood. “There was a time when I had children and had been divorced for a couple of years,” remembers Jackie. “She’d call and say, ‘Honey, do you want to come and get some leftovers?’ So of course, I’d go over and sometimes she’d be there and sometimes she wouldn’t. There were times when she’d say, ‘I’ve left you a check in the planter outside the front door.’ She’d put a check in a zip-up bag and would say, ‘I don’t want you to spend it on the girls, I want you to spend it on yourself.’”


Tammy’s youngest daughter, Georgette Jones, a country singer who has followed in the footsteps of her mother and her dad, George Jones, also has fond memories of Tammy’s love and thoughtfulness. “One Thanksgiving when I couldn’t be there, she sent me this enormous package — all my favorite foods, packed in dry ice!” she tells *Closer*.

Like her sisters, Georgette savored her mother’s knack for spontaneous fun. “We would be going to Canada when she

To all her children, Tammy was and remains a true inspiration. “Mom was always very big on telling us never to give up on anything that we care about,” Georgette relates. “She’d say, ‘If it were easy, it wouldn’t be worth it. You have to work hard and dig in.’ She had a wonderful work ethic, and passed it on.”

PESTO FUSILLI WITH SCALLOPS

Serves 4

- 8 oz. whole grain fusilli
- 1 tbsp. plus 1 tsp. olive oil or butter, *divided*
- 1 zucchini, *sliced*
- ½ cup cherry tomatoes
- 2 cups chopped broccoli florets
- 1 lb. scallops or uncooked shrimp, *peeled and deveined*
- Juice of ½ lemon
- ⅛ tsp. sea salt
- ⅛ tsp. pepper

1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Cook pasta according to package directions until just tender. Drain.
2. Heat 1 tsp. oil in a large skillet over medium-high. Add

veggies; cook 5 to 7 min. Transfer to a plate. Add remaining oil, scallops, lemon juice, salt and pepper to skillet. Cook scallops 2 min. per side.

3. Combine pasta, veggies and pesto* in a bowl. Top with scallops and grated Parmesan, if desired, and serve.

***For pesto:** In a food processor, pulse 2 cups fresh basil, 2 cloves garlic, ¼ cup pine nuts, 1 tbsp. water, 3 tbsp. grated Parmesan and salt and pepper to taste. Drizzle in 3 tbsp. olive oil and pulse until smooth.

BLUEBERRY LEMON TARTS

Makes 12

- 1 cup pecans
- ½ cup cashews
- ½ cup pitted Medjool dates
- ½ tsp. ground cinnamon
- Pinch of sea salt
- 1 cup plain Greek yogurt or dairy-free yogurt
- 1½ tbsp. honey
- ½ tsp. vanilla extract
- ½ tsp. grated lemon zest
- 1 tsp. freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 1 cup fresh blueberries

1. Line a 12-cup muffin tin with parchment or silicone cupcake liners. In a food processor, pulse pecans,

cashews, dates, cinnamon and salt until crumbly. Press into each cupcake liner. Freeze at least 1 hr. and preferably overnight (the firmer the better).

2. In a bowl, whisk together the yogurt, honey, vanilla, lemon zest and lemon juice. Cover and refrigerate until ready to use.

3. Remove the liners from the muffin tin and transfer to a plate. Scoop a small spoonful of yogurt filling on top of each crust. Top each with a few blueberries.

4. Freeze up to 1 week. Thaw a few minutes before enjoying.

5 TIPS FOR STRONGER BONES

FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS TO PREVENT FRACTURES, BREAKS AND OSTEOPOROSIS

BE CALCIUM CONSCIOUS: A diet low in calcium contributes to diminished bone density, so it's important to get the recommended daily allowance (between 1,000 and 1,200 mg for a healthy adult). Foods that are rich in calcium include yogurt, hard cheeses, sardines, canned salmon, almonds and dark, leafy greens like kale, collard greens and spinach.

GET YOUR DAILY D: Your body needs vitamin D to absorb calcium. One way to boost this nutrient is to catch some rays: Just 10 to 15 minutes of sunlight without sunscreen a couple of times a week usually does the trick. You can also try a supplement (600 IU for people 70 and younger) or include more foods with vitamin D to your diet, like mushrooms, eggs and fish, especially salmon, herring and tuna.

WORK OUT: Like muscle, bone is living tissue that becomes stronger with exercise. Weight-bearing workouts such as brisk walking, hiking, running, climbing stairs and playing tennis are excellent for building bone strength. Yoga and tai chi also increase bone density and aid in maintaining muscle strength, coordination and balance, which helps to prevent falls and related fractures. So get out of your chair and start moving!


WEIGH YOUR OPTIONS: Being underweight increases the osteoporosis, especially in postmenopausal women who have lost the bone-protective effects of estrogen. Likewise, being obese can compromise bone quality and increase the risk of fractures due to the stress of excess weight. If you fall into either of these categories, talk with your doctor about how you can achieve and maintain a healthy weight.

LIMIT ALCOHOL: Heavy alcohol use decreases bone density, so limit your intake to one drink a day.






HANK GARRETT

*The Car 54, Where Are You? star
talks about his life and the divine
intervention that changed it*



Hank starred on *Car 54, Where Are You?* with Fred Gwynne and Joe E. Ross.



"I am truly blessed," he says of his marriage to Deanna-Marie Smith.

As a child growing up poor in New York City's Harlem neighborhood, Hank Garrett, a son of Russian immigrants, was headed for trouble. Worried about the gang he was hanging around with, his concerned mother begged a local politician, who was a customer at her fruit stand, to intervene. "He took me to the Apollo Theater to Sammy Davis Jr.'s dressing room. Sammy said, 'So you're a tough guy? Well, you're either going to go to prison or you're going to die,'" Hank, 89, recalls to *Closer*. With Sammy's help, young Hank got a job setting up the stage for a big band, which put him on a path to the life of a comedian and character actor. Though Hank is best known for playing Officer Ed Nicholson on *Car 54, Where Are You?*, his many other credits include popular TV shows and films like *Serpico*, *Death Wish* and *The Amityville Horror*. Along the way, Hank has accumulated fascinating showbiz stories about Robert Redford, Elvis Presley, Audrey Hepburn and more, as well as some valuable life lessons. He relates them in a new memoir, *From Harlem Hoodlum to Hollywood Heavyweight*, out now.

So how old were you when Sammy Davis Jr. set you straight?

Twelve. He said he saw something in me. I don't know what that was. I guess he felt sorry for me because Sam was also from Harlem. My feeling is that God sent me an angel, and that was Sammy.

Did you ever get the chance to tell Sammy how he changed your life?

Yes. Some 20 years later, I was on stage at the Sands. I was doing comedy as Tony Bennett's

opening act. Ringside were Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin, Peter Lawford and Sammy Davis Jr. [Later] Sammy said to me, "You're a funny cat, man. But where do I know you from? You look so familiar." We ended up hugging, and we both cried. It was a funny feeling as people walked by seeing two men sobbing!

Of course, you became famous playing Officer Nicholson on Car 54. Is it true that you almost became a police officer in real life?

I always had a lot of anger for the cops because of the way we were treated on the street. The assumption was if you were on the street, you were a hoodlum. And if you're a hoodlum, you must be doing something unlawful. So I thought I could make a difference. I went to the police academy, but I was fighting the system. I found that I couldn't, although I tried very hard.

How did you get the job on Car 54?

A friend of mine got me the interview. It was with [producer] Nat Hiken, who was a very unassuming guy. He said, "Sit down," and then not another word. I kept waiting for him to say something. Then he said, "You're Ed Nicholson." I said, "No, I'm Hank Garrett." He said, "Just the dummy I am looking for. Ed Nicholson is the character!"

That's so funny! Did you enjoy working on the show?

I kept saying, When am I going to wake up? It was an amazing dream. I was recognized everywhere I went. *Car 54* is still being shown.

HEART to heart

Did anything funny ever happen while you were filming the show?

One time, Al Lewis, who played my partner, and I were on a break in the Bronx. So we walked into an Italian deli in uniform. The guy makes the sandwiches, and when we go to pay, he said, "I like to give my food away." So we say thank you. It was June, but on our way out the door, he yells, "Merry Christmas, officers!"

Is it true that you broke Robert Redford's nose while filming the fight scene in *Three Days of the Condor*?

Yes, he slipped and came at me headfirst. My elbow caught him square in the face. I thought, "That's *it*. I will never work again."

Did he blame you?

He called me that night and said, "Hank, wait till you see the fight scene. It's the best ever. By the way, you broke my nose." But he also said, "Don't worry about it. My nose has been broken many times. It doesn't matter."

And you once fought Elvis Presley! How did that happen?

When I was appearing at the Sands, I got a call from one of Elvis' people [who heard] I was a martial artist. Elvis rented one of the halls at the Sands for us to spar. He said, "Sensei, please don't hit me in the face because I have a show to do tonight." He was excellent and a gentleman. Very, very

sweet, humble and respectful. We sparred and became friends.

Wow. Where there any celebrities whom you were really excited to meet?

Once, I was asked by my manager if I would like to make some extra money as a bodyguard for some star. A limo comes by, and I see a young woman. And, oh God, it's Audrey Hepburn. We went to the Beverly Hills Hotel for a fundraiser. When we got to the event, she said, "Hank, you're my date." So we sat and had lunch, and they raised \$25,000 for a children's hospital. Later, the chauffeur took me back to my hotel. He told me, "You know, you haven't stopped smiling from the minute you got in the car and saw Audrey." My face was frozen in a big smile.

Why do you think you have had such great staying power in Hollywood?

God is good. I have no other explanation. I try my best, and I never say no to somebody who needs help. We've got a thing now called Hank's Kids. We're trying to get kids off the streets.

That's so inspiring.

When I speak to kids that are incarcerated, I see myself and my son. My oldest had attention deficit and hyperactivity. He was always in trouble and wound up in prison.



What's the greatest lesson you've learned?


That God is good, and he doesn't make mistakes. I tell kids that God sent me an angel and there is an angel waiting for you. But you've got to be ready to listen with your heart.







SAVED MY MARRIAGE

THE PERFORMER REVEALS HER SECRETS FOR A HAPPY, LONG-TERM UNION AND A UNITED FAMILY



Martin and Bette have been married for 37 years.

In 1984, Bette Midler and Martin von Haselberg spontaneously eloped to Las Vegas and wed at the Starlight Chapel. “My wedding was two people — my husband and me — and, of course, the Elvis impersonator that married us,” recalls Bette, who had only known Martin for about six weeks before they tied the knot. “I asked *him!*” she says.

But when Bette married at 39, she was already an Oscar-nominated performer in the habit of making her own decisions and calling all the shots. “We used to fight bitterly,” admits the star, 75, who says the birth of their daughter, Sophie, two years later helped change their priorities and put them on the same page. “We came to the conclusion that we wanted to raise a child. We never wanted to hurt that kid in any way,” she explains. “[So] we stayed together until it got better, and it did.”

The key, she and Martin, 72, have said, was putting family first. “There was a conscious effort to create exactly the life we have,” notes Martin, a former performance artist who quit his job as a commodities trader to support his wife’s career and help raise their daughter. “My husband is probably the greatest father who ever lived. He taught her a foreign

language. He taught her how to cook,” Bette says. She also praises **Martin as a partner.**

“He has looked after me for many, many years. He’s sacrificed a lot.”

Bette, meanwhile, learned how to compromise, something she’d never **had to do before.**



In 1984, Bette and Martin wed “on the spur of the moment,” she says.



“Having a child is the best thing I ever did,” gushes Bette.

“Listening is very hard. And compromise. Compromise is the hardest of all,” she admits.

When things go wrong, she came to understand how important it is not to take it out on your spouse. “The blaming, I think, is the worst part,” Bette says. “It’s because you don’t want to carry the burden yourself. You want to push it off on someone else. But honestly, you have to learn not to do that.”

Every marriage has its difficult moments, and Bette feels grateful that she and Martin worked on theirs instead of giving up at the first sign of trouble. “I think it’s [about] perseverance,” she says. “Continuing to put one foot in front of the other.”

Today, the couple lead a peaceful life in Millbrook, N.Y., where they practice tai chi together and support the New York Restoration Project, which helps to create green, open spaces in New York

communities. They often like to curl up on the couch and reminisce. “We look back [at the difficult times] and wipe our brows and say, ‘What the hell was that?’” she confides.

MORE TO LOVE

One year ago, the couple’s actress daughter, Sophie, 34, married Harry J.N. Guinness in an intimate ceremony at their New York home. “They are very joyful together. So it gives me a lot of happiness, tremendous happiness,” says Bette. And despite the lessons she has learned about marriage, Bette avoids offering the newlyweds any advice. “I think the best thing to do if you are a mother-in-law is to back off and let them have their lives and realize that you are not living their life,” she says. “You don’t have all the answers. It’s up to them to find their own life and the answers.”
