What is DUPIXENT?

- DUPIXENT is a prescription medicine used:
 - to treat people aged 6 years and older with moderate-to-severe atopic dermatitis (eczema) that is not well controlled with prescription therapies used on the skin (topical), or who cannot use topical therapies. DUPIXENT can be used with or without topical corticosteroids.
- DUPIXENT works by blocking two proteins that contribute to a type of inflammation that plays a major role in atopic dermatitis.
- It is not known if DUPIXENT is safe and effective in children with atopic dermatitis under 6 years of age.

Who should not use DUPIXENT?

Do not use DUPIXENT if you are allergic to dupilumab or to any of the ingredients in DUPIXENT. See the end of this summary of information for a complete list of ingredients in DUPIXENT.

What should I tell my healthcare provider before using DUPIXENT? Before using DUPIXENT, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you:

- have eye problems
- have a parasitic (helminth) infection
- are scheduled to receive any vaccinations. You should not receive a "live vaccine" if you are treated with DUPIXENT.
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known whether DUPIXENT will harm your unborn baby.
 - Pregnancy Exposure Registry. There is a pregnancy exposure registry for women who take DUPIXENT during pregnancy. The purpose of this registry is to collect information about the health of you and your baby. Your healthcare provider can enroll you in this registry. You may also enroll yourself or get more information about the registry by calling 1 877 311-8972 or going to https://mothertobaby.org/ongoing-study/dupixent/.
- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known whether DUPIXENT passes into your breast milk.

Tell your healthcare provider about all of the medicines you take including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

Especially tell your healthcare provider if you:

- are taking oral, topical, or inhaled corticosteroid medicines
- have atopic dermatitis and asthma and use an asthma medicine

Do not change or stop your corticosteroid medicine or other asthma medicine without talking to your healthcare provider. This may cause other symptoms that were controlled by the corticosteroid medicine or other asthma medicine to come back.

How should I use DUPIXENT?

- See the detailed "Instructions for Use" that comes with DUPIXENT for information on how to prepare and inject DUPIXENT and how to properly store and throw away (dispose of) used DUPIXENT pre-filled syringes and pre-filled pens.
- Use DUPIXENT exactly as prescribed by your healthcare provider.
- Your healthcare provider will tell you how much DUPIXENT to inject and how often to inject it.
- DUPIXENT comes as a single-dose pre-filled syringe with needle shield or as a pre-filled pen.
- DUPIXENT is given as an injection under the skin (subcutaneous injection).
- If your healthcare provider decides that you or a caregiver can give the injections of DUPIXENT, you or your caregiver should receive training on the right way to prepare and inject DUPIXENT. **Do not** try to inject DUPIXENT until you have been shown the right way by your healthcare provider. In children 12 years of age and older, it is recommended that DUPIXENT be administered by or under supervision of an adult. In children younger than 12 years of age, DUPIXENT should be given by a caregiver.

- If your dose schedule is every other week and you miss a dose of DUPIXENT: Give the DUPIXENT injection within 7 days from the missed dose, then continue with your original schedule. If the missed dose is not given within 7 days, wait until the next scheduled dose to give your DUPIXENT injection.
- If your dose schedule is every 4 weeks and you miss a dose of DUPIXENT: Give the DUPIXENT injection within 7 days from the missed dose, then continue with your original schedule. If the missed dose is not given within 7 days, start a new every 4 week dose schedule from the time you remember to take your DUPIXENT injection.
- If you inject more DUPIXENT than prescribed, call your healthcare provider right away.
- Your healthcare provider may prescribe other medicines to use with DUPIXENT.
 Use the other prescribed medicines exactly as your healthcare provider tells you to.

What are the possible side effects of DUPIXENT? DUPIXENT can cause serious side effects, including:

- Allergic reactions (hypersensitivity), including a severe reaction known as anaphylaxis. Stop using DUPIXENT and tell your healthcare provider or get emergency help right away if you get any of the following symptoms: breathing problems, fever, general ill feeling, swollen lymph nodes, swelling of the face, mouth and tongue, hives, itching, fainting, dizziness, feeling lightheaded (low blood pressure), joint pain, or skin rash.
- **Eye problems.** Tell your healthcare provider if you have any new or worsening eye problems, including eye pain or changes in vision.

The most common side effects of DUPIXENT in patients with atopic dermatitis include: injection site reactions, eye and eyelid inflammation, including redness, swelling and itching, and cold sores in your mouth or on your lips. The following additional side effects have been reported with DUPIXENT: facial rash or redness.

Tell your healthcare provider if you have any side effect that bothers you or that does not go away.



SCHEANA'S SWEETIE



Taking a Breather








THE WEEKND & ANGELINA JOLIE





Now, three months later, new documentaries are shedding even more light on what Britney has endured since her conservatorship began 13 years ago. In Controlling Britney Spears, a former member of the 39-year-old's security team claims those in charge — including Britney's dad, Jamie Spears, 69 — had been tracking her every move and even had her bedroom bugged. "Britney feels completely devastated," one source tells *Us.* Adds a second insider: "She wasn't lying when she said her life was a living hell. And it's become quite obvious her pain and suffering has been far worse than anyone knows."


SPY GAME

In the doc, Alex Vlasov — a former employee of Black Box Security — claims that Britney's business manager, Robin Greenhill of the Tri Star Sports & Entertainment Group, had total control of the "Toxic" singer's daily life. She couldn't even have a

friend over without permission. "[It was] like a minor who needs their parents' consent," Vlasov recalled.

His company was in charge of giving Britney medicine in pre-packaged envelopes, as instructed by Jamie. Vlasov claims his boss, Edan Yemini, put an audio recording device in her bedroom and secretly taped 180 hours of conversations with her boyfriend and kids. (She shares sons Sean Preston, 16, and Jayden, 15, with ex-husband Kevin Federline). "Ethically it was just one big mess," Vlasov said. He also alleged that Greenhill wanted to mirror Britney's phone with an iPad hooked up to her iCloud, and that he was asked to encrypt Britney's messages and send them to Jamie. This allowed them to monitor things like her FaceTime calls, photographs, internet history and text messages.

A third source says Jamie has been spying on his daughter since the conservatorship began back in



2008. "In the beginning, it seemed as if it was done for Britney's protection," the source says, noting that Jamie only recently fired Black Box when Britney hired her new attorney, Mathew Rosengart. The second source adds that Jamie started "dialing back some of his controlling behavior when the #FreeBritney movement was gathering momentum because he didn't want to give anyone ammunition."



SHE SAID

The explosive allegations are shocking to many — but not Britney. "She knew about [being monitored] and complained, but no one believed her," says the first source. Now, she can't help but feel vindicated. "For so many years, people have said she's paranoid and crazy," adds the third source. "The people around her lied to her face. She feels betrayed — it's extremely creepy to hear that someone put recording devices in your bedroom!"

HE SAID

Jamie is insisting everything he's done as Britney's conservator has been "legal and above board," says the second source. (Following the debut of Controlling Britney Spears — and two days before a scheduled Sept. 29 court date — Britney's lawyer filed new documents asking for Jamie to be immediately suspended and accused him of "horrifying and unconscionable invasions of his adult daughter's privacy.") Former Los Angeles County district attorney Steve Cooley tells *Us* that while

"audio or video recordings of the confidential communications of another are in violation of California law, it's very rarely prosecuted."

There's also concern that a potential leak of the audio tapes could derail the "Sometimes" singer's push for freedom from the conservatorship — especially if it were to expose any questionable behavior on her part. Says the third source, "Britney doesn't want anything going public."

LOOKING AHEAD

Britney has sworn revenge. The third source says she's taking Jamie to court to "recover the millions of dollars she feels he shouldn't have received" - including 1.5 percent of the revenue from her Las Vegas residency, which ran from 2013 to 2017. "What did he do to earn that money? Nothing," explains the source. In papers filed on Sept. 22, Britney's lawyer argued that Jamie's "mismanagement of Ms. Spears' Estate is evident and ongoing," and that he "took unwarranted commissions from his daughter's work,

totaling millions of dollars." Adds the source: "Britney hates her father and what he's done to her."

The silver lining for Britney has been her fiancé, Sam Asghari. The second source says planning her wedding to the model, 27, has been a most welcome distraction. "Britney is so excited," shares the source. "Finally, the world is getting to see that she's not this vulnerable lost soul — she has the man of her dreams and fire in her belly to stand up for justice." US



Sources say new couple and expecting parents John Mulaney and Olivia Munn are thinking of pumping the brakes



ohn Mulaney is the first to admit it's been an eventful year. "I went to rehab in September [2020], I got out in October, I moved out of my home from my ex-wife," he recently told talk show host Seth Meyers on his late-night chatfest. "Then in the spring I went to Los Angeles and met and started to date a wonderful woman named Olivia," he added of his new girlfriend, actress Olivia Munn. "And we're having a baby together."

Now, four months after *Us* revealed Mulaney, 39, had moved on with 41-year-old Munn — fresh on the heels of his divorce from Anna Marie Tendler — sources say the pair may have some regrets about their whirlwind romance. "Things between John and Olivia are moving fast — too fast," says one insider, noting that the Newsroom alum and standup comedian are already living together. "The baby came out of left field and hit them like a ton of bricks." A second source confirms "it's been a time of uncertainty" for Munn and Mulaney. "This was a fling that got out of control," notes the source. "John and Olivia really have to decide what kind of future they're going to have together, if any."

UNDER PRESSURE

Mulaney is feeling the heat. "This is not a relaxing time for him, baby or



not," says the source, noting that as he copes with the stress of paying for his divorce, the Big Mouth star is staying super-focused on his sobriety. After his September 2020 rehab stint, Mulaney returned to treatment in December for drug and alcohol addiction (he'd been sober since age 23 prior to falling off the wagon). "He's in survival mode," the source explains. "He's living one day at a time and not doing any

long-term planning."

Munn, meanwhile, is catching flak from friends. "Very few people believed things with John were going to last," the source reveals. "Olivia was very happy for him to see other people — many say they weren't exclusive — and if she hadn't gotten pregnant, very few believe she'd be with him now. Olivia's pals can't see them being a couple a year from now."



Adding to the tension is talk about the timeline of their relationship

— and whether or not their hookup had anything to do with the demise of Mulaney's six-year marriage to Tendler, 36. "Friends aren't sure of Olivia's due date or when she and John really got together," says the insider, "but things seem to have overlapped romantically with his ex still in the picture more than they are letting on."

HANGING IN

For now, they're making the best of a complicated situation. "John and Olivia are trying to salvage things," says the source. "Olivia is hopeful, but she doesn't want to pressure John. They're both cautiously optimistic." No matter what happens, their child will be the top priority. "They'll make great parents," promises the source, "but nobody knows if they're going to do that together or apart."

Stuffed Pesto Chicken Breast

SERVES 4

INGREDIENTS

Nonstick cooking spray

- 4 oz cold cream cheese
- 1/2 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
- 11/2 tbsp pesto, store-bought or homemade
 - 1 large egg
- 11/2 tsp Kosher salt
- 1 cup shredded parmesan cheese
- 1/2 cup fine, dried bread crumbs, plain or Italian style
- 4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts (about 4 oz each)
- 2 medium zucchini, halved lengthwise, cut crosswise into ½-inch-thick half-moons
- 1 pint cherry tomatoes
- 2 tbsp extra-virgin olive oil
- 1/2 tsp freshly ground black pepper Cooked pasta, for serving (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Preheat the oven to 400 degrees. Spritz a sheet pan with cooking spray.
- 2 In a small bowl, combine the cream cheese, mozzarella and pesto. In a separate shallow bowl, whisk the egg and ½ tsp of the salt. On a flat plate, stir together the parmesan and bread crumbs.
- Slice a horizontal pocket into each chicken breast; do not go all the way through. Stuff each pocket evenly with the pesto/cheese mixture.
- d Dip the stuffed chicken in the egg mixture, then coat both sides with parmesan bread crumbs. Place on the prepared sheet pan, leaving 2 inches space between the breasts. Arrange the zucchini and cherry tomatoes around the chicken. Drizzle with the oil and sprinkle with the remaining 1 tsp salt and the pepper. Using clean hands, gently toss the veggies to coat.
- breast reads at least 165 degrees, 18 to 22 minutes. If the bread crumbs are starting to burn, lightly cover the chicken with foil. Remove from the oven and let rest for 5 minutes.
- 6 Serve the chicken with veggies on the side and a small portion of pasta, if desired.

The Guilty

Jake Gyllenhaal is such an engaging actor that he can spend nearly every shot of a movie glued to a desk and still manage to captivate. Yet he can't rescue a gimmicky, lackluster thriller that's a near shot-for-shot remake of a 2018 Danish project (that you likely

never saw). His Joe Baylor is an L.A. cop-in-trouble doing subordinate time as a 911 operator. He's restless and bored on his last shift — until he takes a call from a woman named Emily (the voice of **Riley Keough**), who whisper-cries that she's been abducted and hiding in a moving vehicle. After alerting authorities, Joe takes it upon himself to lead the investigation from his dimly lit station.

It's an intriguing premise that fails to reach maximum tension because of the constraints of the format. And with a few exceptions — briefly walking into another other room, fumbling with an asthma inhaler — Gyllenhaal is stuck staying static.
